

Forms of Worship in Christian Denominations

Lesson Aim

Know and Understand how and why different Christian denominations have different forms of worship

Starter

Rebus for the key words: liturgical, charismatic

Activity 1

Resource: Reading texts and table

Copy each different text onto a different colour paper.

Hand out one copy of each text to each group, so there is one text per person, and the group as a whole have all three texts to hand.

Hand out to each student a Table for completion

Give students 3 mins to make notes on info in the text, writing it down in their table, then shout "change" for them to pick up another text, and make notes on that, etc.

Feedback:

- Feedback meaning of liturgical & charismatic.
- Elicit difference between the two types of worship in terms of more to less structured worship
- Elicit ways in which worship shows this.

Activity 2

Writing Exam Question Practice

Resource: Exam Framework Question sheet

Activity 3/ Plenary

Make two paper balls. Ask students to pass them in opposite directions, while music is playing ("Here I am to worship - YouTube").

Stop the music: whoever has paper must answer a question set by the class eg. about an aspect of worship, compare/ contrast two denominations, name and explain a difference.
